Early Head Start works with our local school systems, MCCSC and RBB, on transition to pre-school or Head Start. We make referrals to First Steps of Indiana. ### Eligibility Requirements

- You must live in Monroe County.
- Expectant mothers and children up to age 3.
- Family income must fall within federal guidelines.
