

How it Works

SCCAP's Energy Assistance is a heating benefit program that provides a one time benefit to help pay your winter fuel bills. The average benefit our clients received in 2022-2023 was over \$750.

Applications for the 2023-2024 season will become available to the public on October 2nd, and that is also when the online application site will be live.

Benefits will be starting on November 1st. If you were on the program for the 2022-2023 season you will be mailed an application as soon as they are available. If you would like to request an application to be mailed to you, please email eap@insccap.org with your full name and address.

If you need immediate assistance please call 211 or text 898-211 for more information. You can also reach out to your local township trustee.

Eligibility for the program is based on total household income. If a household's utilities are included in rent, they can still be eligible for program. For program year 2023-2024, income limits by family size are:

1 Person	\$29,755
2 Persons	\$38,911
3 Persons	\$48,067
4 Persons	\$57,223
5 Persons	\$66,378

Fresh Filters



CLEAN OR REPLACE FILTERS ON FURNACES ONCE A MONTH OR AS RECOMMENDED AND USE THE FILTER RECOMMENDED BY THE FURNACE MANUFACTURER.

Vapor Barriers



COVER UP ANY EXPOSED SOIL IN BASEMENTS AND CRAWL SPACES. UNCOVERED GROUND CREATES A PATHWAY FOR A SIGNIFICANT AMOUNT OF MOISTURE. THAT ADDED HUMIDITY MAKES AIR CONDITIONERS WORK MUCH HARDER THAN THEY NEED TO.

How to Apply

To request an application be mailed to you, please contact your local SCCAP office or email eap@insccap.org with your name, address, and phone number in case we need to contact you.

You must turn in the following information:

Application: The application must include everyone living in your household at the time of application. Please fill it out completely. Application must be signed and dated.

Photo ID: a copy of a photo ID (e.g. driver's license) for the person who signs the application.

Social Security Cards: Copies of Social Security cards for each member of the household.

Electric and Heating Bills: Copies of the most recent electric and heating bills.

Income Documentation: If you or any household member has *fixed income* (Social Security, SSI, pension, etc.) we need the most current award letter or a recent bank statement showing the direct deposit. For anyone over 18 with earned income (employment), we need your most recent paystub, showing the year-to-date gross amount. For anyone with zero income for any of the last 3 months you will need to complete an Income Verification Affidavit.

SCCAP Agency Referral Form: Completed, signed and dated.

Landlord Affidavit: *Only needed if your utilities are included in your rent. Your landlord will need to complete this form.
