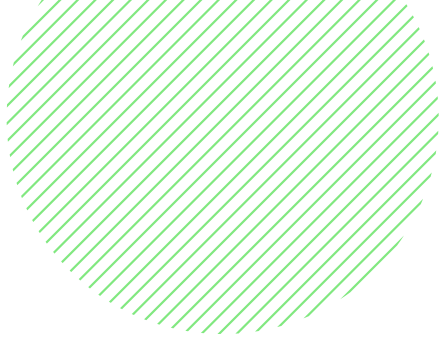


# What is Growing Opportunities?
