Growing Opportunities



Our Programs

Energy Assistance Program

The purpose of the Energy Assistance Program is to help keep members of low-income families safe and healthy, and assist them in achieving energy self-sufficiency and avoiding utility disruptions. We provide assistance with winter energy bills for households in Brown, Monroe, Morgan, and Owen counties. SCCAP's winter assistance program typically begins in November.

Weatherization

Weatherization is the process of increasing the energy efficiency of a home (whether it is a mobile home or a site-built house) and improving health and safety conditions for its occupants. As defined by the Department of Energy's Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP), Weatherization includes a wide variety of energy efficiency measures and serves low income families free of charge (homeowners or tenants alike).

Housing Choice Opportunities

Housing Choice Vouchers provide vouchers for low-income households so they can seek housing. South Central Community Action Program offers Housing Choice Vouchers in Brown, Monroe, Morgan, and Owen counties within U.S. Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) guidelines.

Head Start & Early Head Start

Head Start promotes school readiness of young children from low-income families throughout Monroe County. Head Start and Early Head Start programs support the comprehensive development of children from health care and education to family services for children ages birth to 5, in classrooms. Head Start services include early learning, health, and family well being.



Covering Kids & Families

Covering Kids & Families facilitates and advocates accessible and equitable health for all Hoosiers with a primary focus on healthcare coverage and children's development.

We assist with Medicaid, Hoosier Healthwise, HIP, or Marketplace application process start to finish.
