Housing Choice Opportunities



Energy Assistance Program

The purpose of the Energy Assistance Program is to help keep members of low-income families safe and healthy, and assist them in achieving energy self-sufficiency and avoiding utility disruptions. We provide assistance with winter energy bills for households in Brown, Monroe, Morgan, and Owen counties. SCCAP's winter assistance program typically begins in November.



Weatherization

Weatherization is the process of increasing the energy efficiency of a home (whether it is a mobile home or a site-built house) and improving health and safety conditions for its occupants. As defined by the Department of Energy's Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP), Weatherization includes a wide variety of energy efficiency measures and serves low income families free of charge (homeowners or tenants alike).

Head Start & Early Head Start

Head Start promotes school readiness of young children from low-income families throughout Monroe County. Head Start and Early Head Start programs support the comprehensive development of children from health care and education to family services for children ages birth to 5, in centers, child care partner locations, and in their own homes. Head Start services include early learning, health, and family well being.



Growing Opportunities

Growing Opportunities is a social business project of SCCAP. We are an urban hydroponic farm that provides fresh produce and nutrition education. We grow produce that is sold to local eateries, supermarkets, hospitals and schools. We also donate a substantial portion of our produce to local food pantries and provide nutrition education videos and workshops to the community. The revenue helps make the project sustainable and increases the availability of fresh, local produce year-round in our community.
